



# Research goal/objective:

The current study aims to understand why certain customers scroll through the content for a long time before choosing a show and the barriers preventing them from choosing the show faster (ideally under 5 minutes).

Apple TV+ is looking for ways to improve the viewer experience by making changes that meet customers' expectations.

Our objectives for the research project are as follows:

- Understand how users are currently searching for shows on AppleTV+
- Discover viewers' motivations when choosing a show
- Learn about any pain points users are encountering during their process, and what improvements can be made

Every interview will last for about an hour and will be recorded.

### **Compensation:**

As a sign of appreciation, the participant will get a branded bowl with the Apple TV+ logo, a package of popcorn and a Gift Card for \$100. (The Gift Card will be attached to a personalized Thank You card, wishing the participant an enjoyable experience with Apple TV+ and thanking him/her for the time spent.)

### **Consent details:**

Before the interview starts, we will ask the participants to sign the Consent document, ensuring the results will be strictly confidential and used to improve the viewers' experience.

# Warm-up questions:

As a way to make the participant feel convenient and open to talk, I will ask a few warm-up questions:

- Tell me a little about yourself
- Do you work from home or in the office?
- Are you a morning person or a night person?
- How long have you been watching Apple TV?
- What is your favourite show or movie?

### **Interview questions:**

#### Analysis of the search process:

- Tell me how you found the show last time while you watched Apple TV.
- Do you find the search system helpful?
- How long it usually takes for you to find a show?
- Are you mostly looking for a specific show?
- Which Apple TV interface feature do you find the most helpful?
- Describe the situation when you experienced difficulties searching for a show on Apple TV.

#### **Analysis of the Apple TV+ content:**

- Tell me what were your reasons to sign up for the Apple TV+?
- For how long have you been using Apple TV+?
- Tell me what show/movie categories you prefer.
- Are you often searching for a show with a specific actor/director?
- Tell me what country or region where the show was produced plays the role in your search.
- Is English your mother tongue?
- What role does language play in your selection of shows?
- Do you feel comfortable reading subtitles?
- Give me an example of when you felt uncomfortable when watching the show.

## Interview questions:

### Analysis of the viewers' environment

- Please describe your environment when you watch TV.
- Are you usually watching Apple TV alone or with family/friends?

(If the answer is "watching alone", skip the next questions.)

- Describe the TV preferences of the people watching with you.
- Describe how you decide on what to watch as a group.
- Would you incorporate watching TV shows as part of group entertainment?
- Is it usually harder to find a show when watching with your family members or friends?
- What days a week do you usually watch Apple TV?
- What time of day do you usually watch Apple TV?
- What helps you to choose the show?

#### Analysis of the factors in choosing the show:

- Tell me what kind of show genre or themes are most interesting for you.
- What do you think about the artistic quality of movies and shows on Apple TV?
- Tell me how important it for you is to learn about something new by watching the TV.
- Tell me what kind of movies and shows you would like to see more.
- Do you feel that the Apple TV content is generally aligned with your political views?
- Is it important for you to see actors or plots that are similar or closely related to your own culture and background? Why?
- How important is the diversity of characters, themes and opinions for you?
- Can you give me an example of a negative experience with an Apple TV+ show or movie?
- Tell me if the fact that the movie or show won some prizes plays the role in your selection.
- Are you usually watching the Oscar winners?
- What other festivals you are interested in?
- Are you often specifically looking for festivals' or Oscar winners?

## Interview questions:

#### How the Apple TV+ interface can be changed or improved:

- Are you feel comfortable using the Apple TV remote?
- Are you using voice commands when searching for a show?
- Tell me about your experience with spelling when you search.
- Tell me if the show descriptions are informative and helpful.
- Is the way the shows are presented visually help you to decide?
- Is the movie trailers help you to decide?
- How often do you watch Apple TV during the week?
- What do you think about the possibility to create your own custom search?
- What features would make your custom search process faster?

#### Comparison with other streaming companies:

- Do you have a subscription to any other streaming platforms?
- If yes, tell me what the difference is between them and Apple TV+.
- Can you find the show on another platform easily?
- Do you find the content on other platforms relevant?
- Give me an example of a show or movie you found particularly interesting on a different platform.
